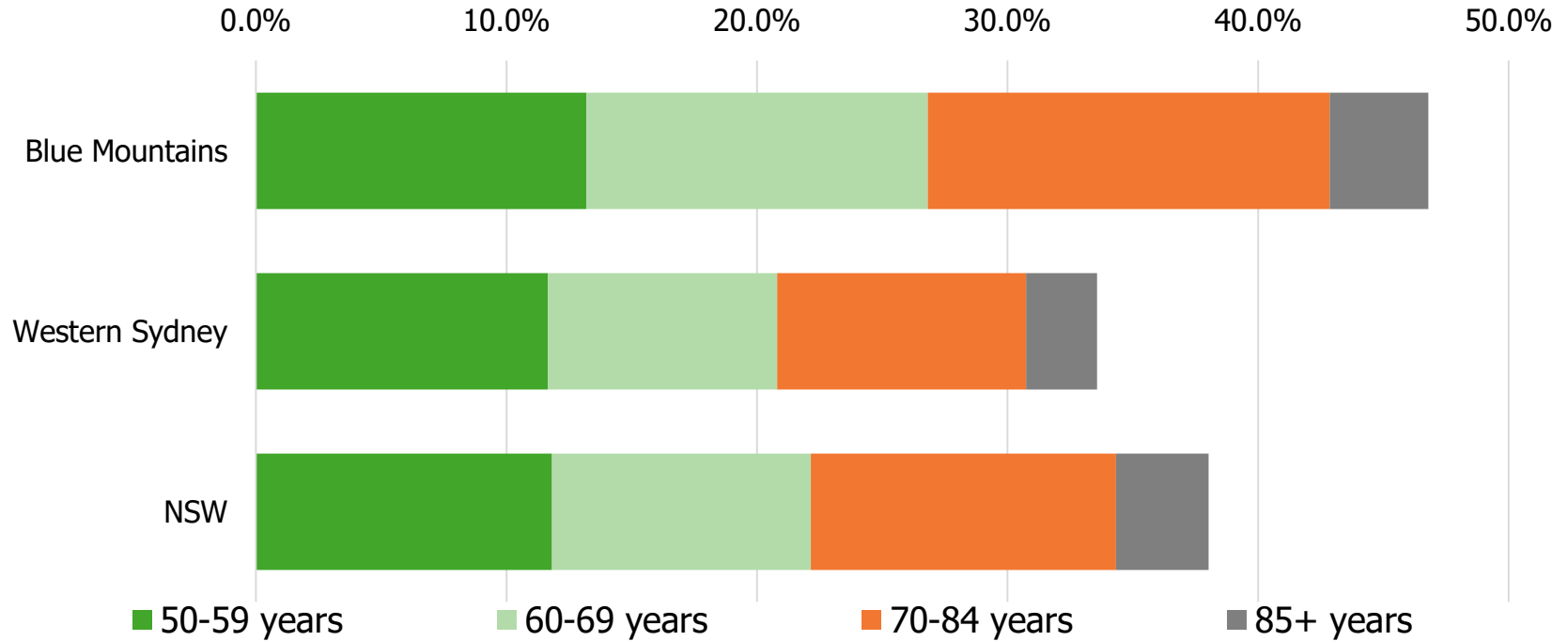


BLUE MOUNTAINS ELDER ABUSE COLLABORATIVE

- Established Elder Abuse Collaborative 2015
 - Developed DRAFT Resource Kit for services

 - Hosted in partnership with EAHRU Awareness training days with services including the Blue Mountains Community Care Forum as part of World Elder Abuse Day.
 - Facilitated case conferences on elder abuse with the collaborative to ascertain a way forward to assist the older person
